**What is the Car Control Clinic?**

The Car Control Clinic is essential for improving your driving skills and becoming more aware, more controlled and safer in everyday driving. It is open to drivers of all ages and consists of classroom instruction and in-car exercises. CCC students must be at least 15 ½ years old and have a valid learner's permit or license. See below for AutoX requirements. Parents of students with a learner's permit must attend the events. Parents of young drivers are encouraged to attend and observe.
